

Privacy Statement

Craigie Baptist Church (hereinafter referred as *'the Church'*) is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to *'the Church'* website and governs data collection and usage. By using the *'the Church'* website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

'The Church' is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites which you may choose to link to from *'the Church'* website. *'The Church'* encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from its site.

Collection and Use of your Personal Information

Images of individuals in photographs or film collected are treated as personal information under the Privacy Act. Consent is not required to collect photographs of identifiable individuals unless the picture records sensitive information about the individual. However, *'the Church'* will take reasonable steps to tell the individual who we are, and what you are taking their picture for, and how they can get access to it later. The Privacy Act protects the personal information of both adults and children alike. *'The Church'* will use particular care in the handling of the images and other personal information of children. Depending on the age and ability of the child to understand an explanation about what is going to happen with their picture and to make a truly informed choice, *'the Church'* will discuss and seek permission to use with their parent or guardian first. *See Footnote*

Disclosure of your Personal Information

'The Church' will only disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law, or in good faith, believe that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on *'the Church'* or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of *'the Church'* and, (c) act under urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of *'the Church'*, or the public.

Security of your Personal Information

'The Church' secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. *'The Church'* also secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure.

Changes to this Statement

'The Church' will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. You are encouraged to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how *'the Church'* is protecting your information.
